Achievement Objective	Technological Practice - Planning for Practice - Level 4
	Undertake planning that includes reviewing the effectiveness of past actions and resourcing, exploring implications for future actions and accessing of resources, and consideration of stakeholder feedback, to enable the development of an outcome.
Learning Intention	I am learning review and record information that guides my practice.
Activity Instructions	 Large Speech Bubbles displayed as colour coded A3 sized wall posters (sentence starters can be modified / changed to suit) Smaller speech bubbles (again colour coded) available for students to use to record relevant information throughout their practice. As students are engaged in review of their practice, record, possibly using sentence starters provided information that informs their practice. 4.
Teacher Notes	 Initially developed by Vincenza Golding as a strategy that encouraged discussion and recording of information relevant to the development of a student's outcome. Strategy needs to be introduced one aspect at a time. Once introduced, students can use independently of teacher. Strategy can be used whole class, group, individually.
